Department of Hearing and Speech faculty member **Lauren Mann, Ph.D.**, is one of the first 50 providers nationwide of Lenire, the first and only dual-mode technology granted approval from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for the treatment of tinnitus. In patients with tinnitus – ringing or other noises in one or both ears –  $\underline{\text{the}}$   $\underline{\text{device}}$  stimulates the tongue at the same time a treatment sound is played to the ears. It takes sound therapy and strengthens it by involving the nerve endings in the tongue. Bravo.
